- Stall holders should be at the site by 8am, to prepare for a 9am start.

- Price all your items clearly before you arrive.
- Consider if you are open to negotiation on prices.
- Please secure any cash you have on your person, you are responsible for your own cash and sales; no responsibility is taken by the event organisers.
